SERMON BULLET POINTS

Chapter 1: The Power of Praise and Purpose

Theme: Entering God's presence with thanksgiving and aligning with His purpose.

Key Verse:

"In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths." — Proverbs 3:6 (NKJV)

- Importance of praise to shift focus from problems to God.
 - God's purpose is victorious and unchanging.
 - Rejection of disappointment, embracing a future in Christ.

Chapter 2: Power in the Blood

Theme: Victory through Christ's sacrifice.

Key Verse:

"They overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death." — Revelation 12:11 (NKJV)

- Repeated affirmation of the power in Christ's blood.
 - Encouragement to declare victory through faith.

Chapter 3: Choosing to Follow Christ

Theme: Commitment and joyful obedience.

Key Verse:

"So listen to me, my sons, for all who follow my ways are joyful." — Proverbs 8:32 (NLT)

- Commitment to follow Jesus without turning back.

- Listening daily for God's wisdom brings joy and transformation.

Chapter 4: The Cross and Its Revelation

Theme: Redemption, surrender, and love demonstrated at the cross.

Key Verse:

- Christ's suffering as the demonstration of God's love and justice.
 - Surrender and brokenness lead to healing and restoration.

Key Verse:
